

## GLANDS AND SENILE CATARACT

### WHAT VITAL ART DOES THE GLAND PLAY IN SENILE CATARACT?

Vogt of Amsterdam considered cataract as a normal biological phenomenon of senility. As graying hair. His work I am sure you are all familiar with. We all know that the prognosis is always poor in cases of diabetes, oral infection, lack of proper diet so far as giving much help in cataract cases. Within the past year I have paid closer attention to the part that the glands might play in senile cataract cases, and the following two cases give me reason to believe that a lot of research is indicated along this line. Case #1. Female age 69. At least two-thirds of the lens was involved, with the heaviest deposit in the right lens (Central). Naked vision 20/80-1. 20/70-1. After 3 daily syntonizations 20/70 plus 2 and 20/40-1. At this time we were able to give her 20/30 - 20/25 with correction. Now I know that some of you have had similar experiences of fast recoveries. Here I would like to go back to Vogt's reasoning in comparing grey hair with senile cataract's. Could malfunctioning glands be the basic cause of both? This case showed me an Alpha Omega pupil in the first examination. So the first step in my procedure was, NL 3, AW 8, W 5, AW 8. Next day the opacity was lighter in both eyes. Her original symptom still being present, I repeated the same syntonization. Results were even better the second day, so no change was made in the frequency. In five days she left for Valperiso, Indiana, with 20/20 corrected vision.

Two weeks later. Case #2. Male age 78, with very similar findings as case #1. Naked vision 20/150 - 20/40-1. We used the same frequencies as in case # 1. We were only able to keep him here for four days. We gave him one syntonization per day, and sent him home to western Kansas with a naked vision of 20/50 - 20/30. He is to return late this summer for further work.

The reason I am giving you these two cases is this. I believe there is a connection between poorly functioning glands and our senile cataract, and I feel that research should be instituted in this direction. I have seen grey hair resume almost their original color and come in much thicker after a serious illness where gland therapy had been used. So comparing these cases, leads me to believe there is a reason, and that the reason might be the same in the grey hair and the cataract cases. We have learned that the Adrenal gland is over-stimulated in case of fear anger and grief. Now consider the condition of the world today.
