

## HAY FEVER

- CASE HISTORY: Man, 43 old, eyes red, nose running, slight fever,  
-- typical case of hay fever.
- DESCRIPTION: A/S, in fair health, normal pulse, normal blood pressure,  
fever 99 1/10, vision 20/30  
Have refracted patient in winter months and vision was 20/20+  
A bar tender in beer garden and a B1 type with  
no trouble with vision and no visual complaint.
- SYNTONIZATION: 10 treatments of N/L  $\mu \upsilon$  (Mu Upsilon) and no effect noted  
10 treatments of N/L  $\alpha \delta$  (alpha Delta) and hay fever was  
Relieved considerable for a few days but returned more  
Severe than before. Further treatment of both the above  
was to no avail.  
Patient was discharged as a failure.

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
