

LOW DUCTIONS

CASE HISTORY: Male, age 19, student.

Complaint: Unable to concentrate on his school studies.
Eyes would tire almost immediately and would burn and water.
Wearing + .50 sphere fitted about six months ago.
Had been back to the optometrist who fitted the glasses several times but was told nothing more could be done.
Condition has bothered him for the past two school years.

DESCRIPTION: A. Extremely nervous and fidgety. Very quick response in answering questions.

VISUAL CONDITION: Acuity 20/20 either eye with and without glasses.
Ductions almost too low to measure.

SYNTONIZATION: A total of ten syntonizations N/L α (ALPHA) ω (OMEGA) every other day.

RESULTS: Entire comfort and all ductions up to normal. Naturally the patient is very much pleased and will continue his school work which he had decided he must drop.
