Has worn glasses for 40 years

Has found it necessary to doctor for one has trouble

Or another most of life. Complaints of severe ache in both eyes –

Almost constant for past three weeks.

Description: Asthenic – has undoubtedly taken very good care of her health and for

her age general bodily functions are considered normal.

Visual Functions: V.A. old Rx. OD 20/40

Before OS 20/23 Syntonizations.

Same V. A. RX. +2.50+1.00 x 30 Add +2.50

+3.75 +.25 x 100 +2.50

Field charts show decided contraction of form field for right eye.

Moderate contraction for left eye,

Intra ocular pressure noticeable. Pupils extremely sluggish.

Syntonization: υωD Daily for ten days

υω/μυ - 2/1 Three times weekly for 3 weeks μυ Three times weekly for 3 weeks

V. A. OD 20/25 OS 20/122

Field chats show very slight contraction of form field for right eye and normal

field for left eye.

Patient advised to return each two months for series of three syntonizations for the purpose of observation etc.
