AMBLYOPIA

Case History:

Female, age 16. Single. Complains of constant blur for all distances. Has been wearing glasses since eight years of age, without change of Rx. although yearly examinations have been made. Some headache.

Description:

Asthenic. Small for her age. Definite small gonadal teeth. General underdevelopment physically. Apparantly fairly keen mentally.

Visual Condition:

Vision without glasses 0.U. 20/400 Vision with Rx. R. 20/65 L. 20/65 0AU. 20/65

Rx. R +1.75 +2.25 190 L +1.75 + 2.50 190

Syntonazation:

L & & 18 minutes every other day for six syntonizations.

Following these six syntonizations (visual acuity taken second day after last syntonization) the visual acuity was R. 20/43

L. 20/32 and she

reports entire freedom from headache and ntices very much the improvement of visual keenness.

Will continue with syntonizations until no further improvement in vusual acuity is possible.
