EYES ITCH AND BURN

| CASE HISTORY: | Case No. 4795; Housewife; Ag 45. Patient came to me on August 15, 1936. |

| | COMPLAINT: Eyes itched, burned, and felt dry. In the morning when she awakened, she complained of her eyes having a dead and stiff feeling, and also, she said her eyes felt as though they were filled with sand. She did not sleep well, was nervous and irritable, and had headaches at the back of her head occasionally. Her vision at near and far were both dim. |
| DESCRIPTION: | Asthenic, medium height, slender. |
| EXAMINATION FINDINGS: | Patient was wearing OD +.75=.50x105, OS +.50+1.25x60. |
| VISUAL CONDITION: | Acuity NV 20/20-1, OS 20/40-; with the old Rx. OD 20/20, OS 20/25 |
| SYNTONIZATIONS: | Three syntonizations ω (Omega) alternated with $\delta \omega$ (Delta Omega) With no nasthanizations were given daily with four days rest between the last two, making a total of six. |
| RESULTS: | Patient reported after first syntonization that she had no headache, wasn't so nervous, slept better, and that her eyes did not itch, burn, or feel sandy and stiff as previously. After each syntonizations she reported that she was feeling so much better. New Rx was given after the third syntonization, and at the end of the sixth one all symptoms had disappeared. |
| | PRESCRIPTION: On August 20, 1936 the following Rx. Was given OD $+1.0050 \times 30$, OS $+1.75-1.50 \times 135$ with an add of $+1.25$ OU. This afforded an acuity of OD 20/20+2, OS 20/20. Patient was dismissed on Aug 26, 1936 with the happiness of a more comfortable life ahead. |
