

## "A" TYPE CASE

CASE HISTORY: Male, Age 19. Student. Has discomfort and blurring vision while studying.

DESCRIPTION: Syntonic type, apparently very healthy and strong.

VISUAL CONDITION: V. A. 20/15 OD, OS, & OU  
No. 7 finding. R. E. +.50-.25 L. E. +.25-.25.  
All ductions and recoveries very low. Types "A" Type Case. Glasses not prescribed. Has had sinus involvement.

SYNTONIZATIONS: 2 treatments N/L  $\delta$   $\omega$ , 6 treatments N/L  $\alpha$   $\omega$ , all with base in and base out exercises. These were given three times a week. At the end of this time some improvement was shown, but recoveries were still low. Then gave 7 syntonizations of N/L  $\alpha$   $\delta$  twice a week. At the end of this time breaks and recoveries were practically as per expecteds, but showed more plus accepted for close work.

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
