VISUAL CONDITION: V. A. 20/20+. No. 7 finding +.50. "C"
type case. No glasses prescribed.

SYNTONIZATIONS: 2 N/L $\alpha \omega$; 1 L θ ; 1 N/L $\alpha \theta$; 2 L $\alpha \omega$;
3 L θ ; 2 Lmp for 7 min. then θ for 7 min.
These treatments were given three times a
week with base out orthoptics. At the end
of these treatments, vision comfortable,
dismissed without glasses.
