

CORNIAL POWDER BURNS

CASE HISTORY: Black powder burns on cornea. About twenty-four
 Hours old. Patient could not close eye due to pain.
 Vision decreased sixty per cent.

DESCRIPTION: Male. Age 24. Asthenic.

SYNTONIZATION: 3 alternate day treatments μ υ

Results: Pain departed during first treatment. Vision normal
 And scars practically cleared at close of third treatment.
