

### CORTICAL OPACITY

CASE HISTORY: Mr. C. M. Age 56. Farmer  
Complaint: Poor vision, especially at reading and other close work. This has bothered for the past three years..., gradually getting worse. Reports low blood pressure (around 100) for years.
