CASE HISTORY: Miss J.J.F., Female, Age 38.

No past history of ecular disturbance.

DESCRIPTION: Asthenic.

EXAMINATION

FINDINGS: No refractive error, V.A. Normal

Anterior Chalazion, Upper left lid. Size about that of a large pea. Entire lid

infected, some pain.

SYNTONIZATION: Five. L & 8 / p & 1-1. Daily.

RESULTS: After first syntonization Chalazion increased

in size and softend perceptibly. Pain stoped during second syntonization. After third syntonization Chalazion opened and cleard to some extent. Balance absorbed and area found normal two days after last syntonization.
