

DIZZINESS

CASE HISTORY: Mrs. C. O. Age 29 Mother
Complaint: very nervous and dizzy for months.
Does her own housework with very great effort. No energy or desire to do or go anyplace.

DESCRIPTION: Normal weigh. Syntonic Type

VISUAL CONDITION: Uncorrected hyperopia of long standing.
Required +.75 sph. O.D.
+.62 sph. O.S.
Perimeter showed field for green and red
Too large. All other conditions negative.

SYNTONIZATION: Twelve syntonizations given every other day
N/L $\frac{\alpha\omega}{N}$ 2/1

RESULTS: Entirely satisfactory. Dizziness left after the first syntonization and has not returned. Gradual building of energy with the result that at the same time of last syntonization she said she felt herself again and was much pleased.
