

EXOPHORIA AT NEAR  $\frac{3}{4}$  PRESBYOPE

CASE HISTORY: Male Age 43 – salesman  
Complaint: reading blurred, eyes tired.  
Very sleepy when reading.

DESCRIPTION: Syntonic leaning toward pyknic.

VISUAL CONDITION: Acuity 20/15  
Gave +.75 OU for reading. This increased exophoria for near and sleepiness in reading continued altho vision was clear.

SYNTONIZATION: Three treatments L  $\alpha\omega$  (Alpha Omega)  
Nine treatments NL  $\theta$  (Theta) – two treatment per week.  
Along with the syntonics were given base out exercises and + lenses with flasher.

The Patient now wearing +1.25 sph OU for reading only.  
Symptoms of discomfort gone.
