

FOGGY VISION WITH DIABETES

SYNTONIZATIONS: N/L $\mu\delta$ two times per week for two months. Also Used stimulation of internals on the Keystone.

Results: V. A. same old Rx O.D., O.S., and O.U. 20/30. She can read fairly well at near and is quite Happy about it.

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
