

HYSTERICAL

CASE REPORT: Female, Age 30. Married. Wearing glasses OU +.50 prescribed by us in 1932. Complained of headaches and unable to sleep nights. Started to make an examination and the patient became very nervous and hysterical, which made it impossible to complete the examination.

DESCRIPTION: Asthenic; medium height; blond hair; fair complexion; light in weight.

VISUAL FUNCITONS: V.A. Old Rx. OD 20/20
Before OD 20/20
Syntonizations.

Same visual acuity with +.50 OU.

SYNTONIZATIONS: N/L $\mu\nu$ three times a week for two weeks.

RESULTS: Was than able to make examination without difficulty and prescribed OU + .75 for constant wear. Contacted patient 90 days later. She had gained 15 pounds; no headaches and was able to sleep well; also reported that she was very comfortable.

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
