

HAY FEVER WITH LACRYMATION AND
PHOTOPHOBIA

CASE HISTORY: Mrs. M. A. J. Age 51 Housewife.

Complaint: All of the usual symptoms associated with Hay Fever.
Wearing 1.25 sphere O.U. for distance and .50 for reading, separate glasses.
Because of the effects of the Hay Fever on her eyes is unable to do any close work for weeks at a time. This has bothered for several years.

DESCRIPTION: Syntonic tending toward Pyknic. Slow movements and sluggish responses. Not overweight.

VISUAL CONDITION: With glasses acuity is normal.

SYNTONIZATION: N/L p v / p & 3-1
Daily, except Sunday, for nine syntonizations.

RESULTS: Eyes feel better than they have for years
Can do any reasonable amount of close work without undue fatigue. All of the Hay Fever symptoms effecting the eyes have gone.
