

HISTORY:

Case No. 4691; Housewife; Age 36
Patient came to me on May 25, 1936

Complaint: No pep, tired most of the time, low pulse rate. Patient also complained that for past two weeks, especially, that eyelids fluttered, and that here eyes twitched and felt strained. She has been nervous and complained that she had headaches once in a while. Has had dark circles under eyes for many years. pH indicated that she was quite acid.

DESCRIPTION:

Asthenic, medium height; medium weight.

EXAMINATION

FINDINGS:

Patient was wearing no Rx.

Visual condition; Acuity OU 20/25--.

SYNTONIZATIONS:

Eight N/L & v syntonizations were given in all. The first five were given one each daily, and the remaining three every two or three days.

RESULTS:

After the first syntonization patient had more pep, and each day she reported that she was less tired. Had only one headache during the time she took syntonizations. At the end of the eighth syntonization all tiredness, eyestrain, and headaches were entirely relieved. pH revealed acidity not so high.

Perscription: On May 25, 1936 the following Rx was given OD +.50-.50 x 180; OS +.75-.25 x 180. Report on June 13, 1936 indicated that all tiredness, eye twitching, eye strain, and headaches gone, and that the patient had more pep to do things. Report also indicated that Pr (pulse rate) was normal.
