

PHOTOPHOBIA UNDER ARTIFICIAL LIGHT

CASE REPORT: Miss A. T. Age 22
Complaint: Eyes extremely sensitive to artificial light and severe headache. Her work is waitress at night and almost unable to continue because of discomfort.

DESCRIPTION: Tall, thin, Asthenic type. Nervous.

VISUAL CONDITION: With glasses 20/20 each eye.
Rx +.50 cyl x 90 O.U. $\alpha \omega$ pupils.

SYNTONIZATION: Twelve syntonizations given one daily Except Sunday. L $\mu / \alpha \omega$ 1/1

RESULTS: After third syntonization she reported the Headaches gone and that her eyes were Not so sensitive to the light. After the Tenth syntonization her eyes were entirely Comfortable and the $\alpha \omega$ pupils were normal.
