Case Report - November 1937

Miss G., age 16 asthenic biotype, student, complained of blurred vision for distance and near. N. V. O. D. 1/200, O. S. 25/33. No phoria or ductions possible. Syntonized L $\mu\nu$ for thirty-six times from October 24, 1935, to July 8, 1936. Final Rx - - 1.00 O. U; O.D. V. A. 20 per cent, O.S. 100 per centum. Corneal scar O. D. completely disappeared in four months from beginning of syntonization, media now clear, but retina indicates old choroidal involvement.
