Question: What is the definition of nascentize?

Answer:

1. As used in Chemistry: The condition of an element at the moment of liberation from a compound, marked, as in the case of oxygen, by a chemical activity greater than ordinary; the ability to form new compounds by recombination.

2. As used in Syntonics: The act of breaking up old combinations of nervous relationships and rendering the several functions of the nervous system susceptible to the formation of new combinations of nervous relationships under the influence of the selected visible light frequency.
