3. Optometric tests required for the diagnosis followed by the treatment protocols, as well as sample case presentations
4. The four basic syndromes and their treatment protocols. These basic syndrome protocols enable you to treatment for 80% of your patients. (the other syndromes are part of the advanced course.)
5. How to incorporate Syntonics into your vision therapy programs and practice management

6. Ensuring you will have all the information to start syntonics therapy in your practice as soon as possible.
7. Presenting the latest research in a unique way.
8. Photobiomodulation; the impact of light on the physiology of the body and responses that can be made.
9. How Chronobiology, the study of environmental or specific lighting has profound biological effects on our patients.
10. About low level laser therapy, the new medicine, its use in pain management and dry macular degeneration.
11. There will be Demonstrations and workshops with case studies on the application of Syntonics
